CALL TO ORDER: Meeting called to order by Sherry Boschert at 3:10 PM.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Greg moved to accept the 7/14/2022 minutes as presented; Clifton seconded. Approved unanimously.

Old Business

1. **Clean School Bus Program (Deadline August 19)** – No update/news. Tad previously sent around a document to the subcommittee regarding the program.
2. **Police Station Fast chargers** – Clifton mentioned a meeting with Liberty later this month to discuss a local microgrid, powered by the landfill gas to energy plant, that could be used to charge police cars during an extended outage.
3. **Lebanon's Ford F-150 Lightning Truck & Publicity** – F150 EV has been built and is undergoing inspection. It was due to be shipped this week, but currently delayed.
4. **EV Infrastructure RFP** – The authors from Lebanon/Hanover/Hartford plan to meet with officials in their city/town to discuss further.
5. **Increasing EV Outreach and Exposure through City Channels** – Sherry has been working with Melanie McDonald to make updates on the page.
6. **GM Dealer Community Charging Program** – no updates

New Business

1. **Draft Review of Zoning Amendments regarding EV Charging** – Sherry gave a presentation to the Planning Board. (Slides are available on the EV subcommittee page at lebanonnh.gov/ev) Shaun asked David Brooks to move forward on changes to site plan regulations to incentivize or require EV charging in some to-be-determined locations.

2. NH Clean Diesel Program Grants (deadline September 9) – Tad sent information from a company that does conversion of heavy-duty vehicles. Tad was investigating grant opportunities for conversions.

3. Winter EV event in Lebanon – Sherry is interested in a winter EV “ride and drive” event to educate drivers on the feasibility of EVs in winter. She proposed an event in January, possibly using the tunnel as shelter for people if we add outdoor heaters, tables, etc. in the tunnel for shelter. Possibly a joint event with Parks and Rec? Sherry will contact Sierra Club NH, Sustainable Lebanon, and dealers.

4. Federal Funding Possibilities in the Inflation Reduction Act or the Infrastructure and Investment Jobs Act – No discussion.

5. Other business/Open to the Public – Tad mentioned an upcoming EV event in West Newbury, VT on August 13th.
