The City of Lebanon will hold a Local Concerns Meeting on **Thursday, September 21, 2023, at 6:30 PM** at the Council Chambers Meeting Room, 51 North Park Street, Lebanon, NH 03766, to identify the project area, present existing conditions, review the source of funding, present a schedule, discuss the basic scope of the project without a solution presented, and to answer any questions or concerns you may have. Briefly, the project consists of the following components:

- Approximately 800 feet of sidewalk located between 195 Mechanic Street and Slayton Hill Road.
- Construction is currently scheduled for 2025 and is expected to be completed in a 2-to-3-month period.

We anticipate meeting with the nearby property owners, businesses, residents, and any other interested citizens at this meeting and then scheduling individual meetings with those abutters whose property may be directly affected at later dates.

The City of Lebanon Department of Public Works hopes you can join us at this meeting so we may obtain your input and continue the design process. Should you have any questions prior to the meeting, feel free to contact Rod Finley, City Engineer, at 603-558-7123.
