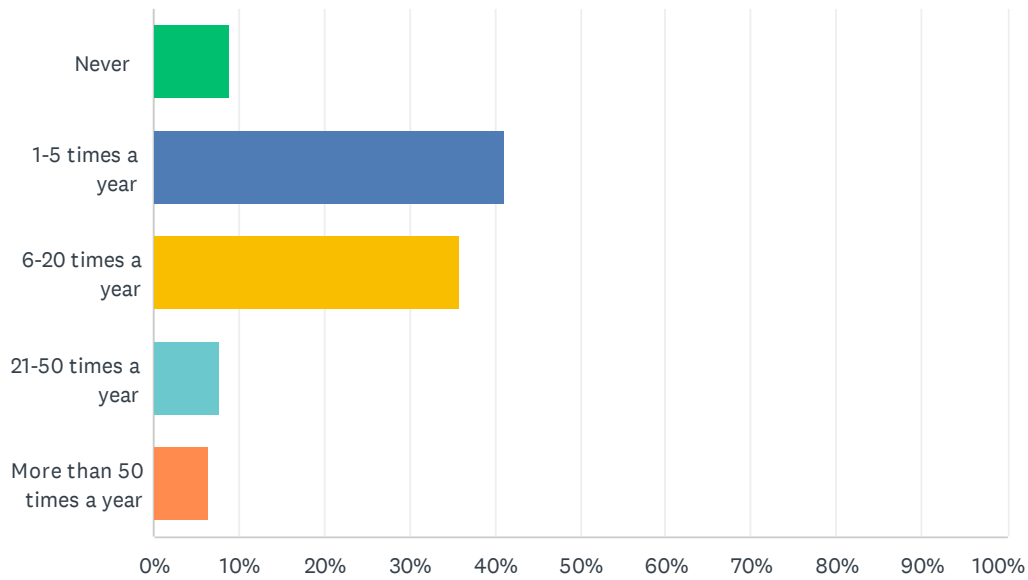

Q1 How often do you utilize the facilities at Storrs Hill?

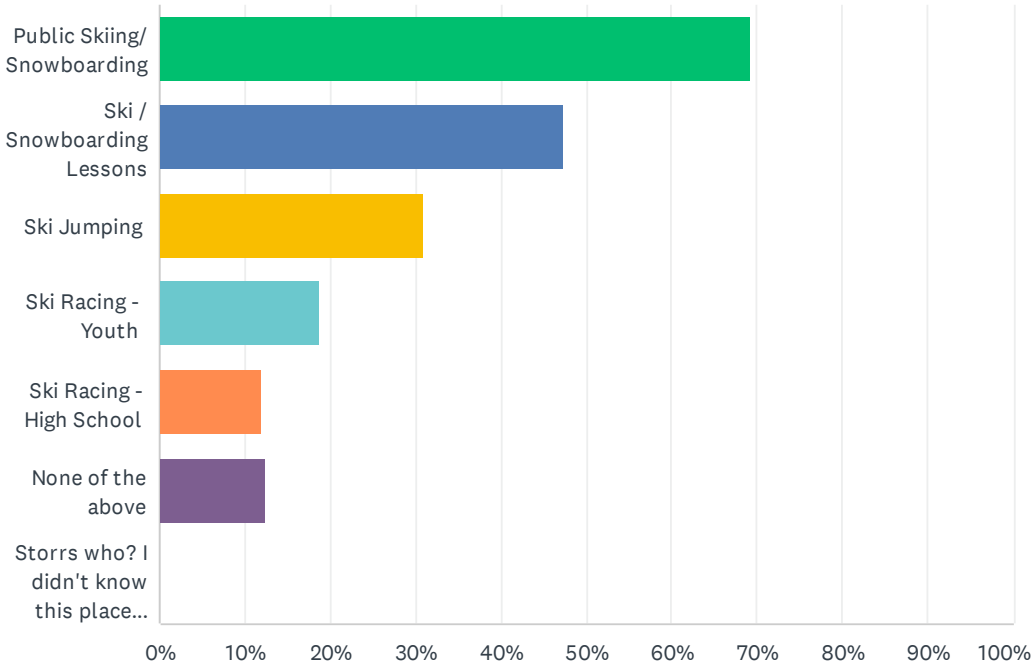

Q2 Please check all the LOC programs that you or your family have participated in at Storrs Hill Ski Area in the past or present.

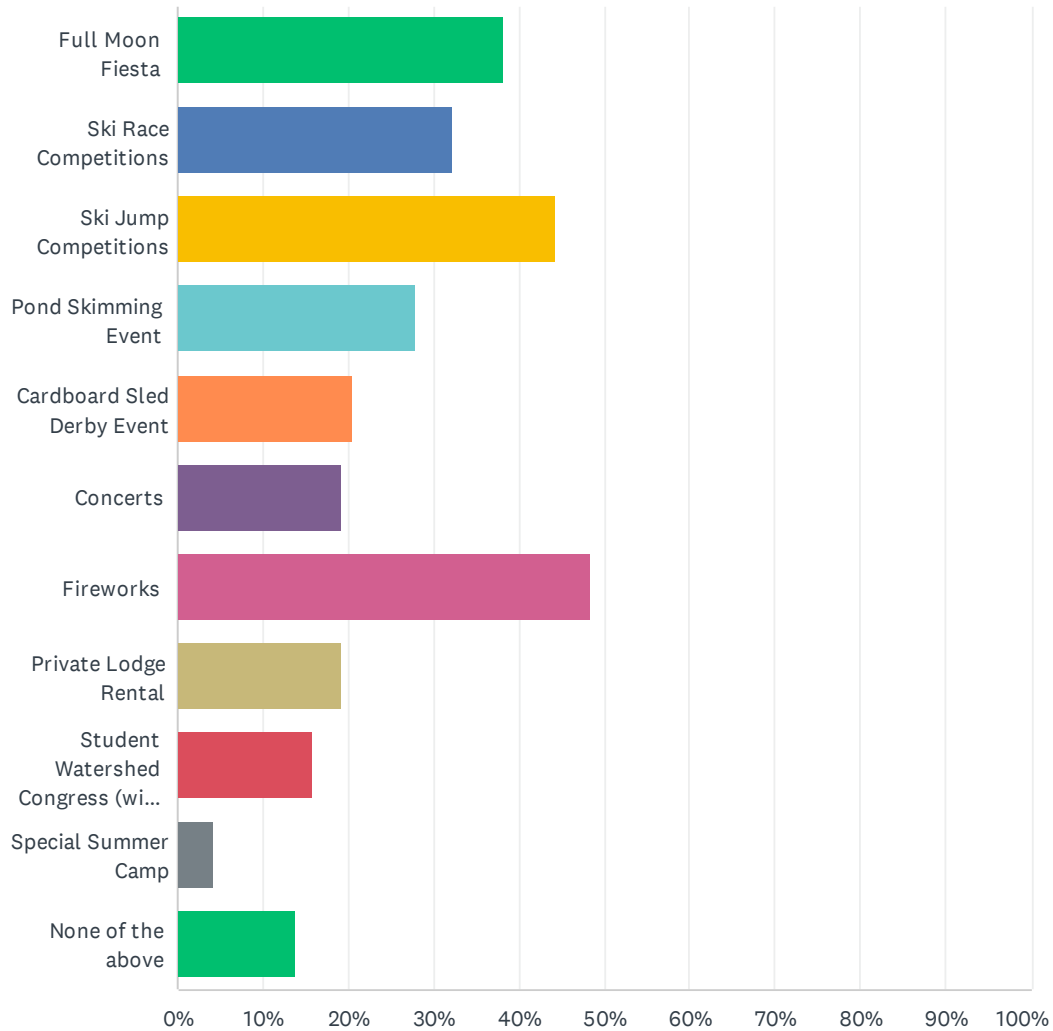

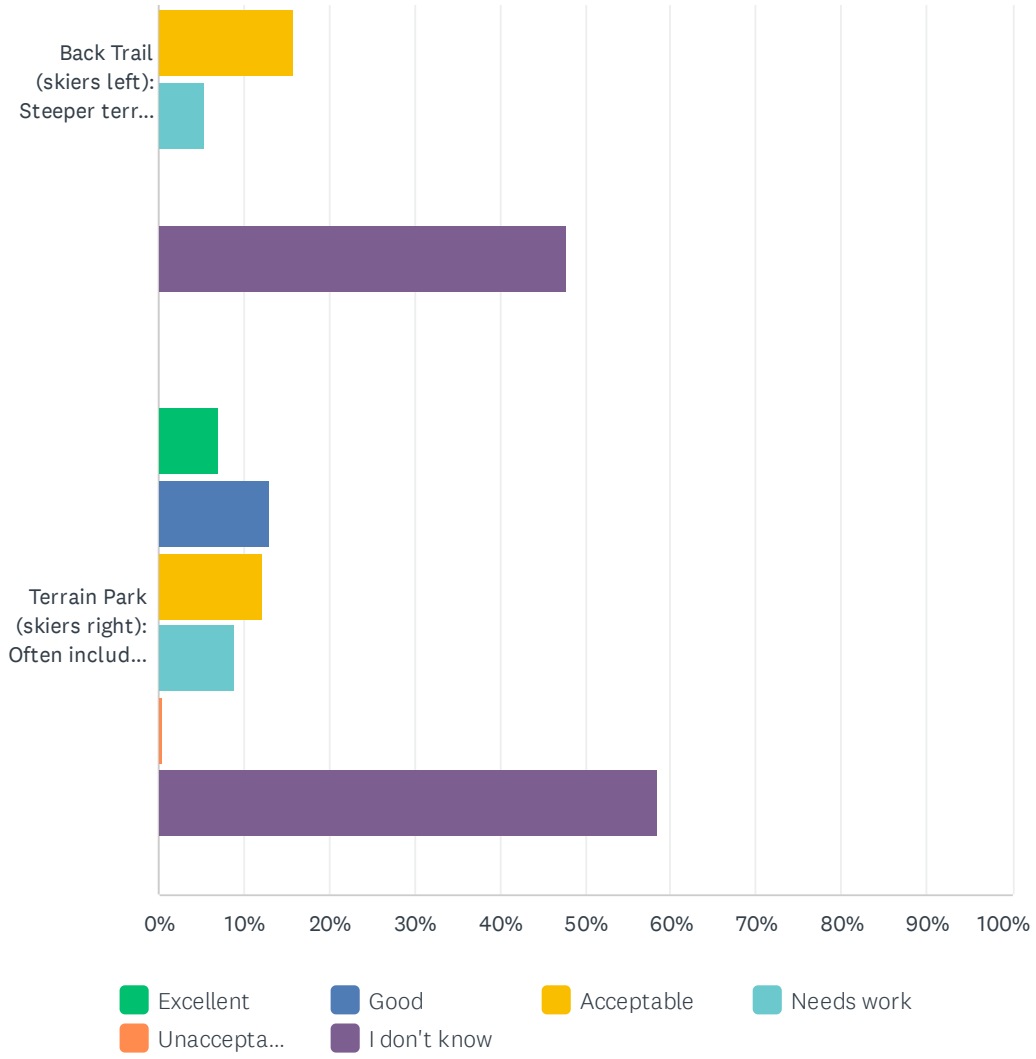
