1. The Public Health Council of the Upper Valley has partnered with the City of Lebanon to conduct a Public Health Needs Assessment. Input from the community is essential in ensuring services are equitable, accessible, and responsive to real needs.
 - A. Identify needs – Determine what programs should be created, improved, or removed to better support the health of everyone who lives, works, visits, or does business in Lebanon.
 - B. Guide planning – Help set priorities for policies and resource allocation to reach key health goals.
 - C. Support long-term strategy – Serve as the foundation for a new Health Chapter in the next [Lebanon Strategic Plan](#).
