A. Environmental Justice Task Force report and its review:

Agenda Item: Environmental Justice Task Force report

Starting in July 2023, representatives from Lebanon's City Council; Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Commission; Conservation Commission; Tree Advisory Board; Lebanon Energy Advisory Commission (LEAC); and Sustainable Lebanon formed a task force and began meeting regularly to explore and develop the concept of Environmental Justice as it relates to the City of Lebanon. This task force met monthly and sought input and suggestions from City departments, external stakeholders, and its own members. From there, it developed a list of recommendations which it spent considerable time developing, organizing, and prioritizing based on the capacity of the City and its value to the community.

The resulting [draft report](#) is enclosed. The task force hopes to present a final report to the Lebanon City Council in the third quarter of 2025, and this report would be most impactful if supported by the endorsement of each of its constituent organizations. The task force is therefore requesting an endorsement from the Tree Advisory Board for this report. It also welcomes

comments or suggestions, though those will be most helpful if brief, specific, and provided to a task force member no later than June 20, 2025.
