CALL TO ORDER: Meeting called to order by Meghan Butts at 3:04 PM.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Clifton moved to accept the 12/10/2020 minutes as presented; Meghan seconded.
Approved unanimously by roll call vote.

If any action is taken by the Subcommittee, list motions and votes:

1. **NH DES DERA Program** – The subcommittee discussed the availability and rules around the diesel emission reduction act funding (part of the Volkswagen settlement). Clifton pointed out that the development of landfill gas to energy plant would make for a good option for charging more City EV's. Greg mentioned Lion Electric school buses - <https://thelionelectric.com/en/products/electric>
2. **Planning Regulations** – Additional work on amendments to the development regulations coming. Potential further discussion at full LEAC meeting.
3. **EV Police Cars** – Some discussion about other towns investigating EV police cars. Should we evaluate fleet-wide replacement options/needs? What about e-bikes for police patrol (especially on the greenway, rail trail, etc)? The Police Department does currently have patrol bicycles. Lebanon is participating in the Upper Valley e-bike library program for three weeks this July, could suggest the Police department demo at this time. Clifton will add to the upcoming LEAC agenda.
4. **Other Grants** – CMAQ (Congestion Mitigation Air Quality) is expanded grants to cover EV charging, etc. Meghan to evaluate.
5. **Other business/Open to the Public** – Clifton gave an update on the City's filing in DE20-170, Electric Vehicle Time of Use Rates.
