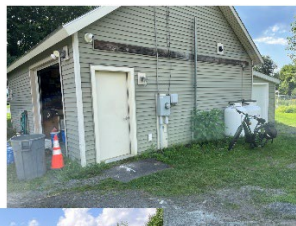
E-bike charging options

Rec & Parks building 1



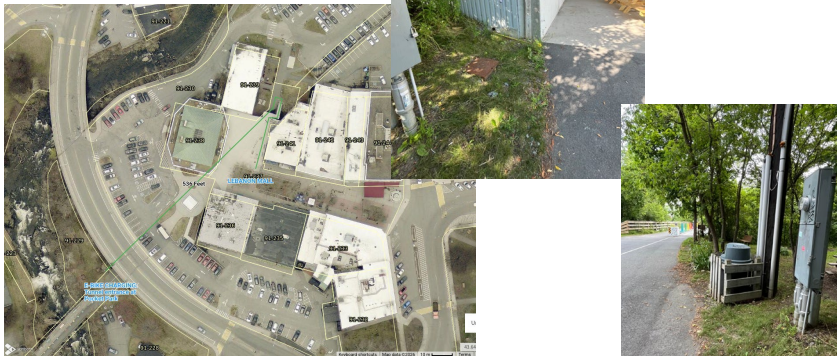
Rec & Parks building 2



Pros & cons: Rec & Parks

- Existing electrical outlet
- May be fastest to launch
- Existing funding sufficient
- May be least cost (\$1,000-\$5,000?)
- Needs details & approval
- Farthest from downtown — 0.3 miles to Lucky's (1,584 ft)
- Initial installation would be on a trial basis

Tunnel @ Pocket Park



Pros & cons: Tunnel @ Pocket Park

- Power supply nearby
- May be 2nd fastest to launch
- Existing funding may be sufficient
- 2nd least costly (\$4,000-\$8,000?)
- Tunnel provides shelter for bikes?
- Needs details & approval
- 2nd closest to downtown — 536 feet to Lebanon Mall
- Security may be a concern

Cement pad



Pros & cons: Cement pad

- Closest to downtown — 204 feet to Lebanon Mall
- Existing cement pad in a great location
- Highly visible
- Design concept known
- Slowest to launch
- Long distance from power source (middle of tunnel)
- Most expensive due to need for long electrical conduit, trenching, etc. (\$15k-\$19k?)
- Need more funding (have ~\$9,300; would need \$5,700 to \$9,000 more)

Summary

- **Distance to downtown:** 1st Cement pad 204 feet / 2nd Pocket Park 536 feet / 3rd Rec & Parks 1,584 feet
- **Speed of launch:** 1st Rec & Parks / 2nd Pocket Park / 3rd Cement pad
- **Visibility:** 1st Cement pad / 2nd Pocket park / 3rd Rec & Parks
- **Safety:** 1st Cement pad / 2nd Rec & Parks / 3rd Pocket Park
- **Cost:** 1st Rec & Parks / 2nd Pocket Park / 3rd Cement pad
- **Sufficient funds:** Yes Rec & Parks / Yes Pocket Park / Not yet Cement pad
